MVA allies to fight on 85 seats each

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Mumbai, 23 October

fter days of stalemate, Maha Vikas Aghadi of Congress, NCP (SP), and Shiv Sena (UBT) on Wednesday announced they would contest 85 seats each in Maharashtra Assembly elections. The three allies are discussing the

sharing of the remaining 33 seats out of the total 288 among themselves and smaller parties.

Addressing a press conference in Mumbai, Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Sanjay Raut said consensus had been reached on 270 out of a total of 288 seats for the November 20 elections.

"We will include Samajwadi Party, PWP, CPI(M), CPI, and AAP. Discussions are still on for the remaining seats. We have amicably arrived at a consensus on 270 seats. MVA stands united to defeat the Mahayuti government," Raut said.

State Congress Chief Nana Patole said the remaining seats would be left for smaller parties. Speaking separately to reporters. Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Anil Desai explained

Priyanka declares assets worth ₹12 cr

Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi, who on Wednesday made her electoral debut by filing a nomination as a Congress candidate for Wayanad Lok Sabha bypoll, has declared assets worth over ₹12 crore. In her nomination papers, Priyanka declared a total income of over ₹46.39 lakh in 2023-2024 which includes rental income and interest from banks and other investments. She is also facing income-tax reassessment proceedings for the assessment year 2012-13, according to which she has to pay over ₹15

lakh as taxes, her affidavit said. Additionally, there are two FIRs and a forest department's notice against her, the affidavit stated.

Her immoveable assets are worth over ₹7.74 crore, which includes two inherited half shares of agricultural land in Mehrauli area of New Delhi and a half share in a farmhouse building located therein, together are now worth over ₹2.10 crore. PTI

The three MVA constituents have arrived at a consensus on 85 seats each (totalling 255). Among the remaining 33 constituencies, the allies are discussing 18 seats among themselves, while the rest segments (15) will be allocated to smaller parties," Desai added.

The seat-sharing talks among opposition members dragged on for weeks due to a bitter dispute between Sena (UBT) and Congress on certain seats, especially in the Vidarbha region and Mumbai. The Congress is not keen to cede ground in Vidarbha owing to its strong showing in the recent Lok

Sabha polls. As the impasse on the sharing of seats continues, minor parties within the opposition bloc, including the Samajwadi Party (SP), Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), Left parties, and the Peasants and Workers Party (PWP), were growing increasingly restless.

Notably, the Akhilesh Yadav-led SP had demanded 12 seats from the MVA quota and declared candidates in five constituencies.

Shiv Sena, NCP release first list for Maha polls

The Shiv Sena and the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) on Wednesday released their first list of candidates for the November 20 Maharashtra assembly polls.

Of 45 candidates in its list, the Shiv Sena has nominated Chief Minister Eknath Shinde from Kopri-Panchpakhadi in Thane city and more than half a dozen cabinet members from their respective seats.

In its list of 38 candidates, the NCP has fielded Deputy Chief Minister and party head Ajit Pawar from Baramati seat in Pune district.

Both the parties have sitting renominated all MLAs who supported Shinde and Pawar PTI

'Artificial rainmaking still under research'

India Meteorological Department (IMD) Director General MRUTYUNJAY MOHAPATRA said the Mission Mausam programme, approved by the Union Cabinet last month with a budget outlay of ₹2,000 crore over two years, will not just improve weather forecasting in the country but also study the potential to enhance or suppress rain. In an interview with Ramani Ranjan Mohapatra in New Delhi, the IMD chief spoke about the improved forecasting system, global warming impact, and artificial intelligence (AI) applications. Edited excerpts:

Can you elaborate on the Mission Mausam programme? Many experts have called for caution in developing artificial cloud chambers.

The objective of Mission Mausam is to improve the IMD's forecast services. Through this initiative, we aim to improve our observation. communication, modelling, forecasting, and warning dissemination systems. Artificial rainmaking is still under research. It has not been told $\mathbb{R}^{\mathbb{R}}$ that we will go for operations. The Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), Pune, has been conducting MRUTYUNJAY research on this for many MOHAPATRA vears. Under this mission, DG, IMD there is a component aimed at further enhancing research on clouds and artificial rainmaking. To this end, there may be a need to establish cloud chambers. The IITM study will not only help us understand clouds better but also explore how this research can be integrated into our modelling systems to improve

forecasts. It will also study the potential to enhance or suppress rain.

How did IMD fare in forecasting the monsoon this year?

The southwest monsoon in 2024 was quite good. Rainfall for the country was 87 cm, or 107.6 per cent of the longperiod average, which was above normal. This matched our prediction that the rainfall would be above normal, with a variation of plus or minus 4 per cent. In terms of spatial distribution, we had predicted that

many parts of the country would experience normal to above-normal rainfall, except for parts of the Northeast, some areas in eastern India, Jammu and Kashmir, Ladakh, and adjoining regions of Himachal Pradesh. Almost 80 per cent of these spatial

predictions were also accurate. This accuracy can be attributed to the multi-model ensemble prediction scheme introduced in 2021, which provides forecasts spatially, monthly, and seasonally. The adverse impact of El Niño was not seen during this monsoon. The monsoon began with El Niño conditions but shifted to neutral



conditions in the middle of the season. In June, rainfall was deficient but returned to normal or above normal in the next three months.

What are the reasons for extreme weather conditions and their longer durations, particularly in Delhi and northern states? Do you think global warming plays a role? There is a trend of delayed monsoon withdrawal from northwest India, which occurred this year as well. Earlier, monsoon withdrawal from Rajasthan used to be on September 1. but now it begins around September 15-17. At the same time, the withdrawal date remains the same over peninsular India, and it has decreased by about a week in central India. Regarding temperature, 2024 was an El Niño year,

and more intense, longer than normal heatwave conditions were observed, as predicted. Global warming plays a role worldwide. Due to global warming, there are noticeable changes in rainfall patterns amid the rising temperatures

Have cyclones become more frequent recently?

The overall number of cyclones has decreased, both in India and globally. However, there is an increasing trend in the number of intense cyclones (extremely severe storms with wind speed of more than 150 kmph) in certain basins, such as the Arabian Sea, since the 1990s. This trend can be attributed, with low confidence, to climate change, based on various studies.

How is AI helping IMD?

At present, AI applications in IMD are limited. We sometimes use AI to estimate cyclone intensity, assess the impact of heatwayes, and make decisions on thunderstorms. We are also developing AI capabilities in collaboration with various institutes. Many research and development initiatives are being undertaken by IMD and the Ministry of Earth Sciences in association with other organisations. There are small developments so far, but I am sure that AI and machine learning applications will be enhanced in the next couple of years.

Cyclone Dana: 1 mn people to be evacuated in Odisha and Dhamra port, located around 70 km away PRESS TRUST OF INDIA

Bhubaneswar, 23 October

As Cyclone 'Dana' barrels toward the Odisha coast, threatening to impact nearly half the state's population, the government is racing against time to execute a massive evacuation plan aimed at relocating around 1 million people in 14 districts to safety.

The West Bengal government has also evacuated more than 114,000 people from vulnerable areas, including Sundarbans and Sagar Island, to safer shelters, according to an official statement.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) said the cyclone may make landfall between Odisha's Bhitarkanika National Park

from each other, early Friday. It said that the landfall process will start from the night of October 24 and will continue till the morning of October 25. "Therefore, heavy rainfall, wind and storm surge will reach the peak during the landfall time which is between October 24 night and October 25 morning," he added.

have decided to suspend flight operations for 15 hours from 6 pm on Thursday in view of the possible impact of cyclone Dana, an official said.

The Eastern Railway will not operate 190 local trains in its Sealdah division from 8 pm on Thursday till 10 am on Friday in view of the cyclonic storm.

IIFL Finance posts ₹93 crore net loss

IIFL Finance Ltd reported a consolidated net loss of ₹93 crore in the quarter ended September 2024 (Q2FY25) as the non-banking finance company (NBFC) made a 100-per cent provision of ₹586.5 crore for security receipts (SRs) in the quarter. These SRs were issued to the NBFC for sale of investments in alternative investment funds to an asset reconstruction company (ARC).

It had posted consolidated net profit of ₹525 crore in the Q2FY24. Its income (revenue) from operations for the reporting quarter was flat at ₹2.318 crore as against ₹2,357 crore in Q2FY24, according to the company's BS REPORTER filing with BSE.

Karnataka Bank on Wednesday reported that its net profit increased marginally by 1.82 per cent to ₹336.2 crore, compared to ₹330.3 crore in the corresponding period of last year. The lender's total operating income rose 10.24 per cent


